God’s faithfulness continues today:

1) He CARRIES me...

³ Then Moses went up to God, and the Lord called to him from the
mountain and said, “This is what you are to say to the descendants of
Jacob and what you are to tell the people of Israel: ⁴ ‘You yourselves
have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles’ wings
and brought you to myself. ⁵ Now if you obey me fully and keep my
covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession...

⁸ The people all responded together, “We will do everything the
Lord has said.” Exodus 19:3-5a, 8a

2) He RECONCILES me...

⁶ At just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. ⁷ Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. ⁸ But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹ Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! ¹⁰ For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life! Romans 5:6-10

3) He COMMISSIONS me...

³⁵ Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. ³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. ³⁸ Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field..." "Freely you have received; freely give." Matthew 9:35-38, 10:8b
