Praise isn't just something relegated to worship services; in fact, it's associated with our every-day lives. In our daily busyness of going to work, loving our families, and walking through the checkout line, we can praise God; we can highlight His greatness and worth. When we praise God, we're giving glory to Him. His light within us shines back to Him. It's as if we're saying, Look! Look at God, at who God is and what He does!

#### We Praise the Lord Because He Is Great

We praise God because He deserves it, and He tells us to praise Him. Because God is so different from us—so fully incomprehensible—His mystery can be frustrating and scary sometimes, especially in seasons of hardship and pain. But, ultimately the fact that God is higher than us, that we can't wrap our minds around the entirety of who He is, is a good thing! We wouldn't want to worship a God who we could completely understand. If we could fully understand Him, then we'd be on His same level and He wouldn't be God. As God reveals different aspects of His character to us and as we come to understand more and more of what He has done for us as His children, we will discover reason after reason to praise Him. I love to think of God that way. There are always more beautiful aspects of His character and love for us to discover. We'll never come to the end of who He is. And, when He shows us more of who He is through His Word and prayer, we respond to that revelation with praise and gratitude.

#### We Praise God Because It Helps Us

God made us. He knows how we were created to flourish and thrive. He commands us to praise Him because He knows the best thing for us is to prize Him as the joy and delight of our hearts. When our relationship with God is prioritized first and we're placing the full weight of not only our eternal security but our emotional and spiritual security here and now on God, we typically give the people in our lives more freedom. And that leads to healthier and more loving relationships and more internal security. Praising God also helps us because it reminds us of the truth of His Word, and gives us a way to turn His gospel truths over and over in our hearts and minds. Over and over again in the psalms, we see men grappling with devastating loss, pain, and fear, only to turn the corner with "but." Then we see God's Word walk them back from the edge of despair. Praising God helps anchor us in the truths of His character and His steadfast love for us. It reminds us that He holds onto us during the good and the bad days. Praising God stirs our hearts up to joy so we can walk in a hope-filled assurance of who God is. It's a reminder that God isn't done with us yet. Though things may look grim now, His truth and Word will hold us until eternity. God has good plans for us still.

#### We Praise God to Make Much of Him to Others

We praise God and shine a light on Him, giving Him glory so that others will see how great He is. We tell of His goodness to other believers to encourage them, to strengthen their hope and faith in Him. We tell of His goodness to those who do not yet know God, so that they can see how all-satisfying a relationship with Him is so that they will want to know Him too. Following Jesus doesn't exempt you from life's storms, so you need to: 1) Remind yourself who's with you – Jesus! Think about it: if Jesus can calm the storm, surely He can prevent it. But He permits us to go through storms to prove that we don't have a problem He can't solve. You may be powerless in the situation, but He's not, and through it you'll come to know Him in a way you never have before. His goal is to bring you out stronger on the other side. 2) Trust what He has told you. When Jesus tells you, 'Let's cross to the other side,' there's not a wave big enough to take you under. The truth is, 'We cannot stand in the storms of life based on someone else's faith. We must be fully assured in our own hearts and minds'. What has God promised you? Stand on it!

**REDEEMING LIF OUTREACH MINISTRIES** is the Mission of the Month for May again this year in honor of Mother's Day! CALLED TO PRESERVE LIFE God is leading Redeeming Life Redeeming Life to expand in Illinois! Redeeming Life Outreach Ministries is a Recognized Service Organization (RSO) of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod and serves single, pregnant women and their unborn children. These women are often at-risk of homelessness, domestic violence, or

choosing abortion. The home and property that they were opening in Carpentersville in the Northern Illinois District (NID) last year fell through. Just last week, their update was that they were trying real hard to get a property and home in East Dundee. We just received their latest letter from them last week. All their prayers were answered, Immanuel Lutheran approved their offer to purchase the property. Please join me in keeping them in your prayers. The Maternity Home Steering Committee and LCEF are partnering with us to preserve life and share the love of Christ with vulnerable young women. Immanuel Lutheran in East Dundee led by Pastor Bill Yonker will be the official host congregation for this new location. This new maternity home will provide a safe, comfortable fully furnished home for the residents to live and thrive in and will be supervised by one full-time, live-in Manager. The residents will engage in self-directed learning and one on-one training with the help of a full-time Program Director. The expectant moms will learn necessary life skills including saving and budgeting, parenting, cooking, cleaning, connecting with others, and most importantly, connecting with God. Prayer, Bible study and worship are important components of the maternity home program. As a pro-life ministry, they walk alongside the mothers on their journey whether they plan to parent or lovingly place their baby for adoption. Every woman who calls Redeeming Life home will find help, love, and support. Please help make this new maternity home in Illinois a reality! No one can do everything, but every individual and congregation can do something! This type of project is very important as the lives of women and unborn children needs help and protection. Single pregnant women who lack safe, stable housing feel that abortion is their only option. Redeeming Life is a positive, prolife maternity home that provides just-in-time resources to redeem the lives of women and babies.

# 5-15-22 Message Outline

#### "Praise the Lord!"

Psalm 148 says: "Let [all creation] praise the name of the Lord, for his name alone is exalted; his splendor is above the earth and the heavens. And he has raised up for his people a horn, the praise of all his faithful servants." Today we ask, why praise the Lord...?

#### 1) I praise the Lord when I discover His <u>PLAN</u>.

The apostles and the believers throughout Judea heard that the Gentiles also had received the word of God. <sup>2</sup>So when Peter went up to Jerusalem, the circumcised believers criticized him <sup>3</sup> and said, "You went into the house of uncircumcised men and ate with them." <sup>4</sup>Starting from the beginning, Peter told them the whole story... <sup>15</sup> "As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came on them as he had come on us at the beginning. <sup>16</sup> Then I remembered what the Lord had said: 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' <sup>17</sup> So if God gave them the same gift he gave us who believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I to think that I could stand in God's way?" <sup>18</sup> When they heard this, they had no further objections and praised God, saying, "So then, even to Gentiles God has granted repentance that leads to life." Acts 11:1-4, 15-18

#### 2) I praise the Lord when I enter His PLACE.

Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. <sup>2</sup> I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. <sup>4</sup> 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." <sup>6</sup> He said to me: "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life. <sup>7</sup> Those who are victorious will inherit all this…
