"What Is True Faith?"

Let's see what God's words say about what faith is: "What does this word, 'faith,' refer to? Faith is the genuine belief and the sincere heart that humans should possess when they cannot see or touch something, when God's work does not align with human notions, when it is beyond human reach. This is the faith that I speak of. People are in need of faith during times of hardship and refinement, and faith is something that is followed by refinement; refinement and faith cannot be separated. No matter how God works, and no matter your environment, you are able to pursue life and seek the truth, and seek knowledge of God's work, and have an understanding of His actions, and you are able to act according to the truth. Doing so is what it is to have true faith, and doing so shows that you have not lost faith in God. You can only have true faith in God if you are able to persist in pursuing the truth through refinement, if you are able to truly love God and do not develop doubts about Him, if no matter what He does you still practice the truth to satisfy Him, and if you are able to seek in the depths for His will and be considerate of His will."

"When you face suffering, you must be able to lay aside concern for the flesh and to not make complaints against God. When God hides Himself from you, you must be able to have the faith to follow Him, to maintain your previous love without allowing it to falter or dissipate. No matter what God does, you must submit to His design and be prepared to curse your own flesh rather than make complaints against Him. When you are faced with trials, you must satisfy God, though you may weep bitterly or feel reluctant to part with some beloved object. Only this is true love and faith."

As can be seen from God's words, true faith doesn't refer to being able to enthusiastically work and expend for God when we enjoy God's grace. Rather, it refers to being able to not complain to God, but to stand in the position of a created being, seek the truth with an obedient heart, achieve understanding of <u>God's will</u>, forsake the flesh, stay loyal to God, and gladly abandon our personal interests to practice the truth and satisfy God when we encounter situations at odds with our own notions—no matter whether they are hardships, refinements, disasters, setbacks or failures, and regardless of how great our fleshly suffering is. This is what true faith means.

Take Job for example. He was faced with Satan's temptations and attacks, losing his family's enormous wealth and all his children and being covered in boils. When Job experienced these extraordinary sufferings, his friends and his wife didn't understand him and instead judged and attacked him, but Job didn't utter one word of complaint. He had true faith in God and believed that all these things befalling him were permitted by God, so he bowed down before God and prayed to seek God's will. By seeking, he understood that everything he had was bestowed by God, that it was natural and right for God to take these things away, and that as a created being, he should obey God unconditionally. So in his extreme pain, Job was able to say: "Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: Jehovah gave, and Jehovah has taken away; blessed be the name of Jehovah" (Job 1:21). "Shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil?" (Job 2:10). From this, we see that when encountering hardships and refinements, Job didn't lose faith in God or speak sinfully, but could seek God's will and preferred to suffer in the flesh to maintain his faith in, devotion to and obedience to God. Thus, he humiliated Satan and bore resounding and beautiful witness for God. This is what true faith means.

DEVOTIONAL OF THE WEEK "For if the correct time for circumcising your son falls on the Sabbath, you go ahead and do it so as not to break the law of Moses. So why should you be angry with me for healing a man on the Sabbath? Look beneath the surface so you can judge correctly." - John 7:23-24 (NLT)

The Sabbath (setting aside one day a week to rest and deepen our relationship with God) was created by God to protect us, not to confine us. We can easily be tempted to work every day; remembering the Sabbath protects us from working ourselves to death. It also reminds us that God's working, not our working, is the ultimate source of all good things in our lives. We don't have to fear that taking a day to honor and relate to God will lead to our "not having enough". So honor the spirit of the Sabbath by using a day per week to draw nearer to God, and rest in His love.

1) Despite lies, I put my hope in God's TRUTH.

¹⁶ This is what the LORD Almighty says: "Do not listen to what the prophets are prophesying to you; they fill you with false hopes. They speak visions from their own minds, not from the mouth of the LORD. Jeremiah 23:16

2) Despite weariness, I put my hope in God's PROMISES.

¹⁷ By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had embraced the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, ¹⁸ even though God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." ¹⁹ Abraham reasoned that God could even raise the dead, and so in a manner of speaking he did receive Isaac back from death...

12 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, ² fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. ³ Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart. Hebrews 11:17-19 & 12:1-3

⁴⁹ "I have come to bring fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled! ⁵⁰ But I have a baptism to undergo, and what constraint I am under until it is completed! ⁵¹ Do you think I came to bring peace on earth? No, I tell you, but division. ⁵² From now on there will be five in one family divided against each other, three against two and two against three. ⁵³ They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against daughter-in-law against mother-in-law."


