In order for you to understand God's will, let's use the word S.H.A.P.E. as an acrostic. **S represents your** *spirit*.

Your regenerated spirit is the part of you that's capable of connecting with God and responding to Him. The Bible says: 'People who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means. Those who are spiritual can evaluate all things'. You can know something in your spirit without understanding it in your brain. Does that sound strange? It's not: 'But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things'. Sometimes a Scripture leaps off the page you're reading in the Bible and you 'know' it's God speaking to you and giving you direction. At the time it may not seem to make sense to you, but it resonates in your spirit as being right. We use different words to describe this experience, such as 'a leading' or 'a prompting'. Will you sometimes get it wrong and make a mistake? Yes. The most mature Christians among us do. In his youth, God spoke to Samuel the prophet four different times before he finally recognized His voice. Just as you exercise your body to make it stronger, you must exercise your spirit to make it sharper and more sensitive to God: 'Solid food is for those who are mature, who through training have the skill to recognize the difference between right and wrong'.

#### The letter H represents your *heart*.

What do you have a 'heart for' or feel passionate about? As a Jew, Paul was passionate about reaching the Jewish people: 'The longing of my heart and my prayer to God is for the people of Israel to be saved. I know what enthusiasm they have for God, but it is misdirected zeal. For they don't understand God's way of making people right with himself. Refusing to accept God's way, they cling to their own way of getting right with God by trying to keep the law. For Christ has already accomplished the purpose for which the law was given. As a result, all who believe in him are made right with God'. You say, 'Does that mean I must be in the ministry to know and do God's will?' No. Nelson Mandela was so passionate about freeing his people from the evils of apartheid that he was willing to spend twenty-seven years in prison to bring it about. When your heart begins to ask, 'What can I do to change this situation?' you may be discovering God's will for you. The people who have made this world a better place all asked that question. Thomas Edison answered it by giving the world incandescent light. Henry Ford answered it by giving the world the car. Mother Teresa answered it by giving the forgotten and dying of India love and dignity. First, Nehemiah wept over the ruins of Jerusalem, then he rebuilt its walls. What moves you? What's in your heart? In answering that question you may discover God's will for your life.


#### The letter A stands for *abilities*.

The Bible says, 'God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well'. What is your dominant gift? You say, 'I don't think I have any gifts.' No one was born without a gift! Your gift may be undiscovered, undeveloped, unused, underused, or even misused, but you have a gift. Have you ever heard the saying, 'There is nothing so powerful as an idea whose time has come'? When you put together the right opportunity with the right gift at the right time, the results can literally blow your mind. Before, life can seem like you're just spending it surviving, when suddenly a crisis arises, a situation occurs, or a door of opportunity opens, and you discover abilities that have lain dormant within you for years. Today you may feel locked into a situation with no way out, but God is 'a way maker' But the Bible says: 'God gave these four young men an unusual aptitude for understanding every aspect of literature and wisdom....Whenever the king consulted them in any matter...he found them ten times more capable than any of the magicians and enchanters in his entire kingdom'. Does that mean you can just sit around and wait for success to be dropped into your lap? No, the old saying 'opportunity knocks' is actually not true. Opportunity waits for those who open the door and go out and look for it.




## Mission of the Month

# "Vindication"

Psalm 26:1 says, "Vindicate me, Lord!" Today we see how and why...

#### 1) Lord, vindicate me because I bear your <u>NAME</u>.

<sup>15</sup>LORD, you understand; remember me and care for me. Avenge me on my persecutors. You are long-suffering—do not take me away;

think of how I suffer reproach for your sake. <sup>16</sup> When your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart's delight, for I bear your name, LORD God Almighty. Jeremiah 15:15-16

#### 2) Lord, vindicate me because I overcome evil with <u>GOOD</u>.

<sup>9</sup>Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good...

<sup>18</sup> If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. <sup>19</sup> Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay,"

says the Lord. <sup>20</sup> On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him;

if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."<sup>21</sup> Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. Romans 12:9, 18-21

#### 3) Lord, vindicate me because I take up my <u>CROSS</u>.

<sup>21</sup> From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. <sup>22</sup> Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to you!" <sup>23</sup> Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns." <sup>24</sup> Then Jesus said to his disciples,

"Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. <sup>25</sup> For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it. <sup>26</sup> What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul? <sup>27</sup> For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done. <sup>28</sup> "Truly I tell you, some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom." Matthew 16:21-28

#### The letter P stands for *personality*.

The worst thing you can do is to envy someone else's personality type and say, 'I wish I was just like them.' That's like saying to God, 'You made a mistake when You made me.' God will help you to change your conduct and strengthen your character, but you can pray until you're blue in the face and He won't change your personality. Instead, He will help you to recognize it and maximize it. The old saying is true: 'Birds of a feather flock together.' Eagles don't want to hang around with ducks. They don't want to live in a farmyard or swim in a pond. Their potential makes them impatient with those who cannot soar. Eagles are loners. Ducks, on the other hand, are team players. Some migrate thousands of miles from the north to warmer climates, flying in a perfect V formation without breaking rank. They know how to defer to one another and care for one another. Before God assigns you, He designs you. He gives you the right personality to fulfil His plan for your life. So instead of putting yourself down or wishing you had a different temperament, say with the psalmist, 'You...knit me together in my mother's womb. Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous – how well I know it'.

#### The letter E stands for *experience*.

How can you know God's will for your life? Paul answers, 'Let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you'. The word 'transform' means 'to change in shape'. How is a diamond formed? It's the result of unrelenting pressure over a long period of time. Your life's experiences will point you towards your life's purpose. God never wastes a pain! The psalmist said, 'I used to wander off until you disciplined me; but now I closely follow your word....My suffering was good for me, for it taught me to pay attention to your decrees'. How do we learn to do what's right? By experiencing the pain of doing what's wrong. You say, 'But others have mistreated me. Is that also part of God's will for my life?' It could be. The reverse side of a tapestry looks like a tangled mess of threads. But that's what it takes to produce a picture of beauty, order, and value. Getting the idea? Re-examine your life's experiences.
