"Sing to the Lord"

Psalm 96:1 Oh sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth! The psalm begins not with a suggestion, but a command to sing to the Lord. To worship Him in song. Singing engages both the intellect and the emotions in worship. Singing in worship is not just for Sunday mornings. You can sing with your mind and you can sing in the Spirit on many different occasions. Notice who is commanded to sing, it's all the earth. As we'll see this includes all nations and all of creation. Everything created is commanded to sing to the Lord in worship. As we worship, our eyes begin to be opened to the greatness of God and we can ...

Tell of His salvation daily

Psalm 96:2 Sing to the LORD, bless his name; tell of his salvation from day to day. This psalm is written to believers. It is only a believer that can tell someone else about God's salvation. You've experienced it and you can explain to someone else how they can experience salvation. Tell others about salvation should be a daily part of our lives, just like getting up in the morning and going to bed at night. Not a day should go by that we do not tell others. We are to ...

Declare God's greatness to all nations

Psalm 96:3 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! To declare something is more emphatic than just explaining it. We are to declare God's glory, not just to our city, not just to our country but among the nations, among all peoples. God's glory speaks of His attributes, such as His love, His holiness, His mercy. Declare His marvelous works speaks of the things He does, such as salvation, healing, answers to prayers and miracles.

This is how you prepare to be a witness for Jesus every day. You get up early enough in the morning to spend some quality time reading the Bible and praying. As you do, your eyes and heart is opened to the glory and works of God. Your faith and commitment to Him grows as you worship. You have prepared yourself for the day. As you go throughout the day, everything you do at work is part of your worship, part of serving first and foremost not your boss, but the Lord. You are praying for opportunities to be a witness for Jesus, to tell of his salvation to others. As you pray, God is working, in you, in others and in the situation. God will open the door every day that you prepare yourself, to let your light shine for Him. Not only should you pray for yourself, but you should pray for your church and the missionaries that we support in America and around the world. Expressing praise to God prepares you for the upcoming day.

Worship the only true God

Psalm 96:4 For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; he is to be feared above all gods. The prevailing view today is that there are many religions, all are equally effective ways to reach God. The politically correct view is the only religion that should be opposed is the one that claims to be the only way. But that's exactly what the creator God and His Word in the Bible teach us. We are to worship only the one true God. He alone is to be feared because ...

Psalm 96:5-6 For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the LORD made the heavens. Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and beauty are in his sanctuary. "A New Song"

Psalm 96:1 says: Sing to the Lord a new song...

1) Sing to the Lord a new song about His TREASURES.

"This is what the Lord says to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I take hold of to subdue nations before him and to strip kings of their armor, to open doors before him so that gates will not be shut: ²I will go before you and will level the mountains; I will break down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron. ³I will give you hidden treasures, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the Lord, the God of Israel, who summons you by name. ⁴For the sake of Jacob my servant, of Israel my chosen, I summon you by name and bestow on you a title of honor, though you do not ac-knowledge me. ⁵I am the Lord, and there is no other; apart from me there is no God. I will strengthen you, though you have not acknowledged me, ⁶ so that from the rising of the sun to the place of its setting people may know there is none besides me. I am the Lord, and there is no other. ⁷I form the light and create darkness, I bring prosperity and create disaster; I, the Lord, do all these things.

Isaiah 45:1-7

2) Sing to the Lord a new song with God-given TRUST.

Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace and peace to you. ² We always thank God for all of you and continually mention you in our prayers. ³ We remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁴ For we know, brothers and sisters loved by God, that he has chosen you, ⁵ because our gospel came to you not simply with words but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and deep conviction. You know how we lived among you for your sake. ⁶ You became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you welcomed the message in the midst of severe suffering with the joy given by the Holy Spirit. ⁷ And so you became a model to all the believers in Macedonia and Achaia. ⁸ The Lord's message rang out from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia—your faith in God has become known everywhere. Therefore we do not need to say anything about it, ⁹ for they themselves report what kind of reception you gave us. They tell how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, ¹⁰ and wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead—Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath.

3) Sing to the Lord a new song from God's TRUTH.

15 Then the Pharisees went out and laid plans to trap him in his words. ¹⁶ They sent their disciples to him along with the Herodians. "Teacher," they said, "we know that you are a man of integrity and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth. You aren't swayed by others, because you pay no attention to who they are. ¹⁷ Tell us then, what is your opinion? Is it right to pay the imperial tax to Caesar or not?" ¹⁸ But Jesus, knowing their evil intent, said, "You hypocrites, why are you trying to trap me? ¹⁹ Show me the coin used for paying the tax." They brought him a denarius, ²⁰ and he asked them, "Whose image is this? And whose inscription?" ²¹ "Caesar's," they replied. Then he said to them, "So give back to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's." ²² When they heard this, they were amazed. So they left him and went away.

Council Meeting Notes

Living Word Lutheran Church Council Meeting Notes Wednesday, October 18, 2023 at 7 pm

Attendees: Bill M, Paul H, Diana M, Phil H, Ken M, Neal H

The meeting was opened with prayer at 7:04 p.m. by Phil.

We then went into financials. There was not much that had changed except we did have to pay the \$504.99 for the water bill which may have been when we had a leak. We had to pay for the drip pan for the AC unit which was \$675. We did go over our color copies, so we need to continue to be mindful of that. We did get \$1,500 back from Pure Energy as we have now moved to a different company for our electricity. Bill had to sign a 2-year contract but is significantly lower than what we were paying before. Preschool was okay, we did have tuition and a donation and then we did have to move some money from preschool back to the general fund when we had to pay Diana at the end of August. Diana also bought some supplies for preschool for Halloween/Thanksgiving from Oriental Trading. Neal had spoken with his accountant about the employment covid fund that the government was doing. We need to pay the accountant \$2,000 but will be getting back \$30,000 which could take up to 10 months.

Diana made a motion that we pay the accountant. Ken 2nd and the vote was unanimous.

We then moved on to Preschool where Diana said we would get our 6th student in January who will be 3 days a week and our 7th in February for 3 days. We do have a family that would like to tour the classroom but has Covid right now so when they are healthy will come for a tour.

Diana then went into the call committee update. We have 4 new names from the district that we will call and see if they are interested in taking a call at this time. We also have a meeting with Pastor Prohl on Saturday, November 4th at 9:30 to talk with the council and call the committee. We will be asking Pastor Prohl what the district is doing and how to help us get a pastor. We will make sure to provide financials to him to show him we are still a functioning church that is not in debt. We want the district to understand we don't want to close our doors.

Diana did mention for the Mission of the Month that late November into early December would be the angel tree for Orland Township. She did mention our church Christmas tree and maybe looked into a pre-lit tree for the sanctuary. We talked about just doing the Christmas setup during a worship service to have more hands to help us get it set up. Diana also said if we didn't want to collect for a tree, we could just collect donations for the Orland Township Food Pantry for the beginning of November.

Neal thanked everyone for stepping in while he was away. We all understand his health comes $1^{\rm st}$ and had no problem taking care of things while he was gone.

The meeting adjourned at 8:08 p.m. with a prayer from Neal.

All nations must worship Him

Psalm 96:7, 9 Ascribe to the LORD, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength! Worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness; tremble before him, all the earth!

All peoples must be told to worship the Lord and give Him glory. All the earth must tremble before Him in feature. The Lord may only be worshipped in holiness, by those who have been forgiven and cleansed from their sins.

Application

As believers, we must be convinced that the Lord we worship is the only true God, the creator of everything. We must communicate the unpopular truth that Jesus is the only way to God. All the other religions are completely false and lead people away from the true God. In today's world, words have become corrupted and many no longer mean what they once meant. The word Christian has lost its biblical meaning of being a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ. Most of the people who claim to be Christian are not according to biblical standards. For a while the word evangelical meant a Christian with a biblical world view. But now heretics who deny the existence of hell, who deny that Jesus is the only way, who deny that those who practice sin such as homosexuality are lost claim the word. A true believer is someone who trusts in Jesus as Savior and Lord and who obeys all of God's Word. The majority of people who claim to be Christian in this country, but are not, are just as lost as the billions following other religions around the world. So, a large part of being a witness for Jesus in St. Louis is convincing people they are not saved, so that they can be saved. Our goal in missions is the create more genuine worshippers of the one true God.
